

**Members' Selective Exhibition 2023**  
**Moores Building Contemporary Art Space**  
**September 15<sup>th</sup> – October 1<sup>st</sup> 2023**

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

1. Entrants must be a full and financial member of CAAWA.
2. Entries close Sunday August 20<sup>th</sup>.
3. Following the entry closure date artists will be asked to confirm the titles and retail price of their pieces between Monday 21<sup>st</sup> August and Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> September.
4. Each piece must be an original work by the artist and have been made in the last 24 months.
5. At least 80% of the artwork must be fired or unfired clay.
6. The work may have been previously exhibited.
7. Collaborative work will be accepted and will be acknowledged as such in the catalogue, price list and any awards.
8. Emerging Artist is defined as someone who is in their first five years of their professional practice and will be eligible for any awards in this category.
9. All members are eligible for the Kusnik Award (the Award of Excellence), with the exception of the two previous exhibition winners. Further awards will be announced at a later date.
10. Up to 2 pieces may be submitted per member.
11. Installations with a maximum dimension of 1x1x1m can be entered
12. Pieces can be displayed either on the wall or on a plinth.
13. Any display requests should be made to the exhibition coordinator. The final decision will be at the discretion of the gallery and the CAAWA coordinator.
14. Each piece is to be marked clearly with the artist's name, number and retail price.
15. Delivery of pieces Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> – Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> September (exact times will be confirmed with applicants) to multiple drop off points in the metro area. If you are unable to deliver at this time, please contact us via email: [exhibitions@ceramicartswa.asn.au](mailto:exhibitions@ceramicartswa.asn.au) for alternative arrangements.
16. There will be a final drop off opportunity on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> September to the gallery directly prior to 11 am. No work will be accepted after this time.
17. Exhibitors must be available to collect any unselected work on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> September, email us at [exhibitions@ceramicartswa.asn.au](mailto:exhibitions@ceramicartswa.asn.au) for alternative arrangements (country exhibitors).
18. All entries must be for sale.
19. A Statement of Supplier Form to be submitted if you do not have an ABN.
20. CAAWA Commission is 25%
21. Entry fee of \$50 per member (non-refundable).
22. All pieces will be subject to selection and the selector's decision is final.
23. All care but no insurance cover is provided for artworks whilst in the care and custody of MBCAS. CAAWA/MBCAS is not responsible for loss, breakage or theft.
24. Any exhibit requiring power must have an electrician's safety tag. (An occupational health and safety requirement).
25. The committee reserves the right to use images of the work for the promotion of the exhibition and on the CAAWA website, Facebook and Instagram .
26. Unsold work to be collected from Moores Building Contemporary Art Space on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> October or at the same drop off points with dates and times to be advised.
